


New Mexico Corrections Department

- Created the Fugitive Apprehension Units to arrest fugitives. The amount of fugitives captured has increased to nearly 3,000 in 2017 from only 117 in 2011.
- Drastically improved security at NM Prisons.
- Streamlined and modernized inmate monitoring system.
- Implemented revolutionary victim notification system.



Responsible Inmate Care:

- 30-bed transitional living center in Los Lunas for women.
- 18-bed Inpatient Mental Health Treatment Center (MHTC) opened for female inmates.
- Implemented four-year Seminary Degree Program for interested inmates.
- Treating inmates with Hepatitis-C & HIV.
- More inmates graduating from the Inmate Residential Drug Abuse Program.
- Working to reduce recidivism by implementing inmate central rehab programs.
