- Tiny Houses – current trend in housing in today’s economy, updated changes to maintain minimum code requirements to provide level of safety to protect occupants
- Conducted inspections at movie sets; chili roasters, special events, throughout state, to ensure public safety, but also not to disrupt economic value to NM
- One Stop Business Portal Act
- All boards have adopted rules and regulations regarding Licensure for Military Services Member, Spouses and Veterans, and electronic signatures.
